

U4C: Community Life at the U4C House

"They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer." Acts 2:42

Rules of the House:

1. The guidelines of the student's respective schools are to be followed by their students.
2. Alcohol, drugs, tobacco will not be permitted in the house. Intoxication is not permitted on or off campus.
3. No opposite sex guests are allowed in the bedrooms.
4. Sex outside of Biblical marriage is not permitted.
5. Overnight guests are not permitted on a normal basis. Extraordinary exceptions must be approved by the Resident Director of the U4C. Requests must be made 24 hours in advance. Resident Director will keep a log of guests, and then give that log to the Program Director & Executive Director monthly.
6. Guests are not allowed in the house by themselves. They must be accompanied at all times by a resident of the community.
7. Students need to be in the house each night before the alarm is set. The community will discuss and decide during orientation the time the alarm will be set each night. The Resident Director and Assistant Resident Director are responsible for setting the alarm.

7. Stewardship of the house
